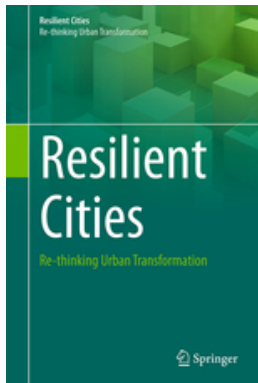

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION

The papers must be prepared and submitted in compliance with these instructions, the Springer's Book Manuscript Guideline (Manuscript Guidelines for English Books) <https://www.springer.com/gp/authors-editors/book-authors-editors/book-manuscript-guidelines> , and using the appropriate template depending from the type of submitted contribution (article or case study).

- It is expected that authors will submit carefully written and proofread material. Spelling and grammatical errors, as well as language usage problems, are not acceptable in the final submission.
- The papers should have a length between 5.000 and 7.500 words.
- The papers should clearly describe the background of the subject, the authors work, including the methods used, and concluding discussion on the importance of the work.
- For case studies, the paper must include a section on "Lessons Learned", a section on "Replication and Upscaling potential" and include the "fiche/resume" part of the template.
- Papers shall be prepared in English (United Kingdom).
- Technical terms should be explained. Acronyms should be written out at their first appearance.
- All manuscripts shall be submitted online, through Easy Chair. (Go to <http://www.unescosost.org/2016/07/11/resilientcitiesbook/>, and click Start Submission button). If you do not have an Easy Chair account, you must create one; after that, you have to enter your user name and password, in order to enter the Easy Chair for "Resilient Cities Call 1". Submissions received by email will NOT be considered.
- For each submission you can upload one file only. The "file name must" follow this format (please substitute the part in [brackets] as appropriate):

ResilientCities_[Surname]_[Name]_[Book number: BK1 or BK2 or etc]_[Topic number T1 or T2 or etc]_[Submission type: AR or CS-LF].doc(x)

- All manuscript must be submitted using the appropriate template for articles (AR) [[160705_ResCity_Book_Template_Article_v02_NT](#)] or for case studies long format (CS-LF) [[160705_ResCity_Book_Template_CaseStudy_v02_NT](#)]. All the template sections must be dully filled, following the template instructions.
- The templates are in MS Word with extension .DOT, including the appropriate Style set, please do not change the style set, remember to activate the macro. Before submission save your file in MS Word with extension *.doc or *.docx
- When submitting your manuscript, you should clearly state the book [BK1, 2,3 etc] and the topic [T1, 2, 3 etc] for which you are submitting it.
- One contribution can be submitted for ONLY ONE SPECIFIC BOOK.
- The authors can submit multiple/different manuscripts for different books and topics.
- The submission shall be in English (UK).

All submissions must be original and unpublished.

All submitted contributions (articles and case studies) will be peer reviewed.

The editors will communicate the first editorial decision to the authors, after the peer review process, which can result with the submission being accepted, accepted with minor corrections, accepted with major corrections or rejected. In case of acceptance with correction the re-submission will be peer reviewed before the second and final editorial decision is taken.
